<About participants guide>

This guide introduces the participation procedure of this event. Since it contains the content necessary for operation, please be sure to read carefully and participate. Also, please cooperate with this guide so that you can print with your participation card and bring it to the venue.

<From admission to event start>

Reception

Admission to the venue is possible from 9:00. Present your participation card at the entrance and <u>tell "player name" and "robot ID".</u>

Participants are also required for participation cards. Be sure to prepare for the number of people. Also, please be sure to lower from the neck and move in the venue. An entrance fee is required if there is no participation card.

Those who do not have a participation card for crime prevention refuse admission to the waiting room.

Since the reception is crowded, please accept the reception on the following times as a guide.

[Procedure of Participation Certificate]

You can print with "My Page" -> "Entry" -> "Competitions in entry" -> "Participation certificate printing".

Please print for the whole team.

[participation fee]

Participants from abroad can pay participation fee at reception.

[When Receipt Required]

If you need a receipt for participation fee, please inform the association "address", "amount of money", "provision" specified in advance.

[If your robot is not registered]

The preliminaries order or the final tournament table are available on the website in advance. If your own robot is not posted here, please contact our association before participating on the day.

Players Waiting Room

Please proceed to the players' waiting room when the reception is completed. There is no seat assignment, so please use the vacant seat.

- ▼ 28th Waiting Room
- 1F foyer: for ROBO-ONE auto
- 3F training room 1: for ROBO-ONE Light
- ▼ 29th Waiting Room
 - 1F Foyer: for Overseas players and seed players

3F training room 1: for Domestic players



 \cdot The waiting room will be one team per chair (2 teams on one desk). Please use desks for each other.

• Please prepare your own table tap to be used for robot maintenance. As the players' waiting room is large, we recommend that you prepare as long a cable as possible.

 \cdot Please prepare lunch for yourself. Although eating and drinking in the waiting room is possible, we ask that you cooperate so that garbage can be brought home.

[Notes]

% We will prohibit the use of batteries whose screening has not passed through the venue. Charging is prohibited as well. Please do not bring in defective batteries as much as possible.

* Please be careful enough for battery management. Members of the team are always managed during charging, and if everyone leaves their seat please stop charging and leave. Please bring the battery to the extent that it can be managed. % Please be sure to carry the battery in its own safety bag.

※ The table of the waiting room is what borrowed from the venue so please spread mats etc. so as not to hurt table.

• Standards screening (Regulation check)

28th Light players will not review the standards before Preliminaries. Only the battery check is performed.

The target of the standard review after Preliminaries will be "players who have completed the 4.5m Preliminaries run", "certified players who have the right to participate in the final tournament", and "the top 3 players in each ranking", so the target players are Proceed directly to the designated standards screening venue immediately after the Preliminaries run. If you want to check before Preliminaries, please check in from 9:00. Please note that if you do not pass the standard review even after passing Preliminaries, you will not be able to participate in the final tournament.

Players on the 28th auto will not review standards before qualifying. Only the battery check is performed.

A recognition examination will be conducted on stage from 12:00.

(1) Standing KHR, (2) Falling KHR, (3) Person, (4) Plastic bottle or nothing Please be able to recognize.

Robots that pass this screening should be checked by the robot at the standards screening site.

On the 29th, we will not review the standards before Preliminaries for the floor exercise, but we will check the battery and measure 20% of the arm tips. The target of 20% arm-tip measurement is "a robot with arms and hands in one piece". "There is a hand" or "A robot with a shape that can be clearly understood as a hand" is not a target. For robot's subject to 20% arm-tip measurement, please mark the entire arm with vinyl tape, etc., at a location 20% or less from the arm-tip before arrival. The target of the standard screening after Preliminaries is "players who have scored 10 points or more", "authorized players who have the right to participate in the final tournament", and "the top 3 players in each ranking". Immediately after that, please proceed directly to the designated standards examination venue. If you want to check before Preliminaries, please check in from 9:00. Please note that if you do not pass the standard review even after passing Preliminaries, you will not be able

to participate in the final tournament.

• [Important] Battery assessment

For safety management, we will review all batteries used in the venue. Batteries that are determined to be dangerous, such as "excessively bulging", "the body and cable coating has been damaged", "connector is disconnected", etc. cannot be used in the venue. Battery that passed the examination sticks a red "BATTERY CHECK OK" sticker. Please do not peel off this seal until the end of the event.



Both days: The standard review is only for those who passed Preliminaries, but the battery review is for all players. After you have arrived, place your luggage in the player's waiting room.

• When abstaining

In case you abstain from participation, please be sure to inform the staff of the standard review site before participating.

Participant Briefing

Briefing of participants will be held from 9:30 on 28th and 29th.

Please gather in the player waiting room on the first floor. (Participants waiting on the 3rd floor should also gather on the 1st floor.)

Schedule

12:50 ROBO-ONE Final Tournament


Preliminaries will be done in 2 lanes or 2 rings. Since it is divided into an odd number (A) and an even number (B) in the order of participation, please line up in the corresponding lane column. As the Preliminaries progresses so quickly, please move to the venue with a margin so that you can line up in line before the 5th run. Do not do dangerous acts such as running with a robot.

It is the same even during Preliminaries. Please do not run beside the running lane or jump over it.


*Please note that the schedule may be changed depending on the progress of the game.

<About special rings outside the stage>

A special ring (C ring) is installed beside the Standards screening site. Please use it freely as it is available from 10:00. However, robots that hurt the ring as well as competition rules cannot be used. Also, if the site is busy, please use it alternately according to the instructions of the staff.

<In the case of an accident such as smoking, fire, etc.>

Disaster prevention goods are prepared in the players' waiting room. Please place

it in a heat-resistant sheet in case of emergency and cover it with a wet towel. Put it in a bucket as it is and bring it outdoors and check to extinguish a fire. In addition, please contact the staff nearby promptly as soon as an accident occurs.
